Moreover, we aim to promote the change in men towards positions more favorable to equality and the breakup of the traditional masculine model, supporting them in the process with the understanding that this will benefit all of us. Last but not least, we want to support the creation of groups and networks of egalitarian men, and to facilitate the exchange of experiences.

APPROACH

We provide discussion groups for men, while fostering masculine change through trainings, workshops, public campaigns, literary gatherings, film clubs etc. This is a mainly volunteer-rooted organization. We occasionally participate in European projects and also draft and publish policy statements on different matters such as sex-trafficking, prostitution, divorce, education, and so. We lobby as well, more effectively at local than state level.

IMPACT

We are the only Spanish country-wide, male association aimed at gender equality and men change. AHIGE is recognized as the strongest stakeholder of its kind in Spain. We have over 180 members and 10 Regional Delegations. There are 21 regular discussion groups with over 400 participants in 15 cities (and one online). 




